REPORT AGENDA

YEA Update

Julie Hammons reported that we had a larger number of jamborees than we have seen in the past and encouraged AD's to submit proceeds in a timely manner. There was a sizeable anonymous donation made to the YEA, designated to fully vest Caldwell High School.

Dairy West Update

Ty Jones reported everything went great with the fall state tournaments and milk distributions. Meeting with Dairy West next week to get things in place for upcoming state events and contracts.

Officials Update

Darren Krzesnik reported that things are going well with the shot clock, some of the 1A schools are not using it but for the most part, everyone is using it with no issues. Discussed what the cost of a lifetime pass would look like if the proposed policy change passes and who would be responsible for that payment. He would like to see how many second-year officials we had come back this year and how waiving first and second year officials' registration fees has affected the officials' pool.

Marketing Update

Zach Hoffman spoke about the new play of the week segment and the new 40th anniversary Dairy West logo that is being using this year. We have one new sponsor, US Army.

2023 4A/5A State Golf Tournament

Julie Hammons reported on the 4A and 5A fall golf tournaments held at the University of Idaho Golf Course in Moscow and the Lewiston Country Club, respectively. Both tournament directors did a fantastic job of organizing the event, and we appreciate their hard work. Pat Laney and Doug Henderson are both new AD's and hosting the first tournament of the year is difficult. They did a great job. This was the completion of the two-year pilot having the 4A and 5A golf tournament in the fall. The State Tournament committee reviewed a request to move the larger school tournaments back to the spring but that request was denied and we will continue with the split seasons moving forward.

2023 State Soccer Tournament

Julie Hammons reported that the State Soccer tournament went well and thanked all the tournament managers for their efforts. There was concern about the quality of the 4A tournament fields at Brothers Park, a site we have used numerous times in the past. Unfortunately, we will no longer be using Brothers Field as a tournament site. The fields were not taken care of and the managers had to do a significant amount of extra work to get the fields playable for our athletes.

2023 State Cross Country Meet

Ty Jones reported everything went great. Travis Bell did an outstanding job running the meet. He was even able to get the location at no cost to the IHSAA so thank you to Travis.

2023 State Volleyball Tournament

Mike Federico reported that the State Volleyball tournaments were held in District I & II. There were three new managers and they all did an outstanding job with each tournament they managed. Our state officials had common meetings with each site manager and coaches to prepare for the tournament. Facilities on the first day of the tournament were full with limited space for spectators, participants and coaches. Expenses were up due to the increase of workers' pay and officials rooms. We had minimal controversy and schools were well represented.

2023 State Swim Meet

Julie Hammons stated the meet went well and we had a lot of talented athletes competing. The space is just not big enough for our State meet and the tickets sold out very quickly, upsetting many patrons. The contract with the West YMCA has expired and we will be sending out a request for bids for future State meets soon. However, to our knowledge, the West YMCA is the largest venue in the state.

2023 State Football & Milk Bowl

Ty Jones reported that the tournament went well. Some of the financials have not been reported yet. It does help financially with more schools hosting at their home sites rather than at a neutral site.

2023 State Drama

Mike Federico reported that State Drama ran well with one minor technical glitch but Dana Facer took care of it and finished the tournament. Talked about the importance of our association and the members schools embracing and supporting the performing arts.

Fall Academic Champions

Julie Hammons reported on the fall Academic State Champions. Congratulations to all our state academic champions, results are on our website.

Statewide Football Bracketing Meeting

Ted Reynolds reported on the statewide bracketing meeting, noting that there are some concerns about a 16-team bracket. Ty Jones talked about a two-year bracketing system for the state football play-offs which was accomplished at this meeting.

NFHS Annual Media Rights Guarantee

Ty Jones reported that we should be getting reimbursement in January and then checks will be disbursed for those schools who are part of the program. We are still under contract with NFHS and will continue to see a profit increase.

Dual Enrollment

Ty Jones reported that new forms will be available and required beginning in the fall of 2024 to track dual enrolled students. This requirement will follow state code.

Committee Reports

State Tournament Committee: Volleyball will include regular season tournaments into MaxPreps rankings. Scoring must be a two out of three or three out of five to qualify.

Volleyball tournament sites will be split up by classification beginning in 2024 and will be a three-day tournament. Softball will not be switching 3A and 4A sites.

Sportsmanship Committee: approved adding parents to the sportsmanship committee and reviewed 2023-24 synopsis.

Policy Manual/Bylaws/Legal Updates

Ty Jones reported on Rule 10 – Officials for football and the process for requesting neutral officials.

Jae Foundation

Student advisory committee members talked about the Jae Foundation and the importance of what they are trying to accomplish and focus on the importance of mental health.

Lifetime Pass for Officials

A motion was made to approve modifying how lifetime passes are determined for officials as a First Reading.

Motion carried

Lifetime passes will not be issued to persons who have retired from a qualified position but are still serving in a capacity in which they are eligible to receive an IHSAA annual activity card.

School trustees who have received lifetime passes may not be issued an IHSAA annual pass.

IHSAA lifetime passes may be issued to:

1. Superintendent of Schools: 25 years of service in Idaho
2. Principal/Vice Principal: 25 years of service, high school level
3. Athletic/Activities Director: 25 years of service, high school level
4. Coach or Activities Sponsor: 25 years of service, high school level
5. IHSAA Executive Director and Assistant Directors
6. IHSAA Board of Directors per one full 3-year term is served
7. School Trustees: 12 years of service in Idaho
8. Hall of Fame Inductees
9. Officials: 25 years of service plus criteria
10. YEA Board of Directors: by criteria

Criteria/Procedure for Receiving a Lifetime Pass:

1. The request for an IHSAA Lifetime Pass must be in writing, submitted by a superintendent or principal of a member school.
2. A fee of \$100 will be charged for each pass issued.
3. The individual receiving the pass must be retired or in the process of retiring. School trustees who have served for 12 years but are not retiring may receive a lifetime pass.
4. Years of total service must be non-concurrent years for school personnel. Officials must have 25 non-concurrent years of service, a letter of support from the District Board of Control and approval from the IHSAA Board of Directors. They may continue to officiate per receiving the lifetime pass.

IMEA State Solo Language

A motion was made to approve modifying how IMEA allows students to qualify for the State Solo contest as a First Reading.

IHSAA Rule 8 - Non-Sport Activities - Music

Current wording: All students who compete in the State Solo Contest are subject to Academic Eligibility Rules 8-1 through 8-1-5.

New wording: Students who audition for All-State or compete in the State Solo Contest are subject to Academic Eligibility Rules 8-1 through 8-1-5, and Enrollment/Attendance Rule 8-8-1.
Non-traditional students - See Rule 8-16.

Sponsoring Baseball as an IHSAA-Sponsored State Tournament

A motion was made to approve sponsoring baseball as an IHSAA-sponsored state tournament beginning in the spring of 2025 as a First Reading.

DISCUSSION AGENDA

1. **Volleyball Ranking Calculations:** Reviewed a proposal from West Ada School District to consider a divider with MaxPreps and number of games played. Tournament games will be considered for rankings if those matches are best 2/3 or 3/5 with regular scoring.
2. **Crimes Against Officials' Legislation:** The Board reviewed a request to support new legislation. They felt that there is a need to check on the wording that the legislation has in place. At this time there is no support until legislation has correct verbiage.
3. **Officials' Salary Comparison:** Recommended all District Board of Control negotiations happen at the same time with aligned contract lengths. Aidrie Voile, our office intern, compiled an officials' salary comparison with recommendations for pay.
4. **MaxPreps RPI:** Proposal from the MaxPreps Committee to evaluate the use of RPI. This model uses winning percentages and there are benefits to using RPI. Some concerns with current MaxPreps rankings are coaches want transparency as to how rankings work. There are some concerns that coaches will still tamper with the outcome of the rankings.
5. **State Tournament Expansion:** The Board asked Ty Jones to create a committee to look at potential state tournament changes. He will report back at the January and April Board meetings. Randy Lords moved; Spencer Barzee seconded to move this to the April Action agenda as a First Reading.

Article VIII - Miscellaneous

Section 7. Review and Audit. A report of Review of Financial Statements will be conducted each year unless ~~for three years.~~ an Audit of Financial Statements is requested by the Board of Directors. ~~will be conducted every fourth year.~~

Article XI

Section 1. Action by Board of Directors. Pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 2, of the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation, and Article X of these By-Laws, the power to repeal and amend the By-Laws and adopt new By-Laws, or to adopt, amend or repeal Rules and Regulations, shall be vested in the Board of Directors. Section 2. Procedures for Action by Board.

A. The By-Laws may be adopted, amended or repealed at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Directors at any such meeting duly called and held. Rules and Regulations may be adopted, amended or repealed at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors upon a majority vote. A By-Law or Rule or Regulation so adopted or amended shall become effective on June 1 of the following year unless an earlier effective date is provided.

B. Any proposed adoption or amendment to a By-Law or Rule or Regulation submitted to the Board of Directors for consideration and action by the Board, shall be introduced only at one of the six regular meetings, but shall not be acted upon by the Board of Directors until a subsequent regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors.

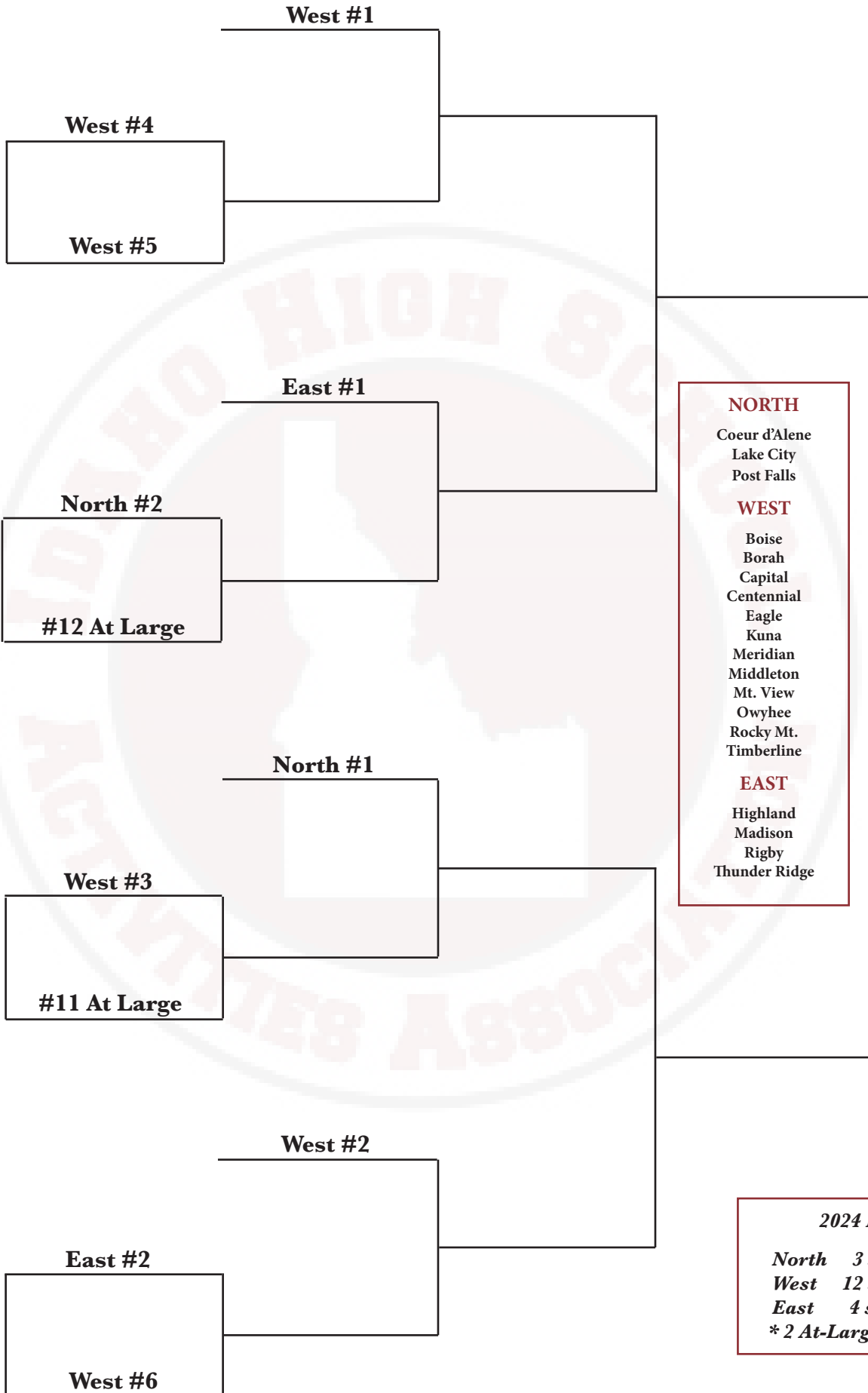

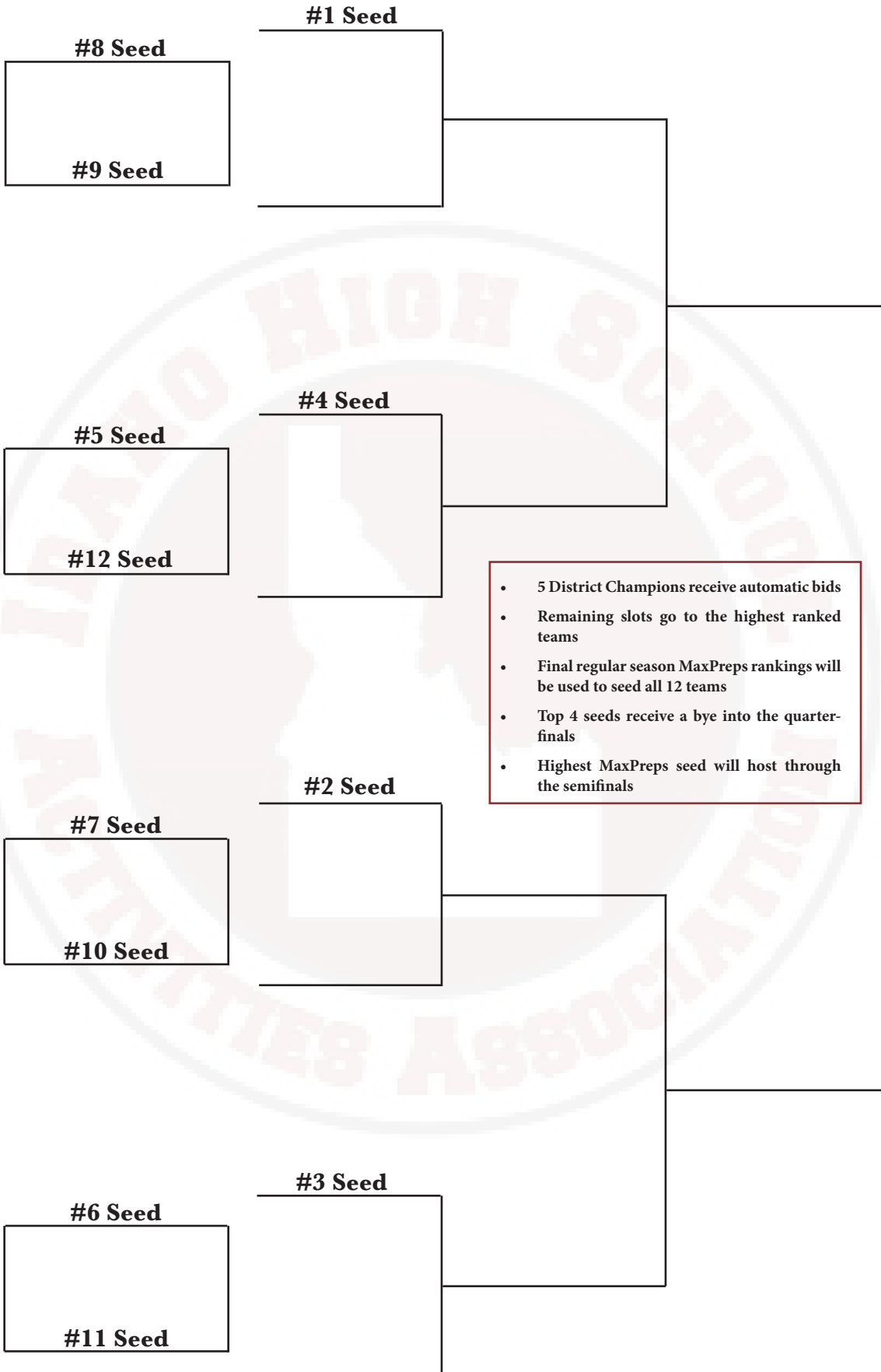

- Semifinals will be hosted at a neutral site

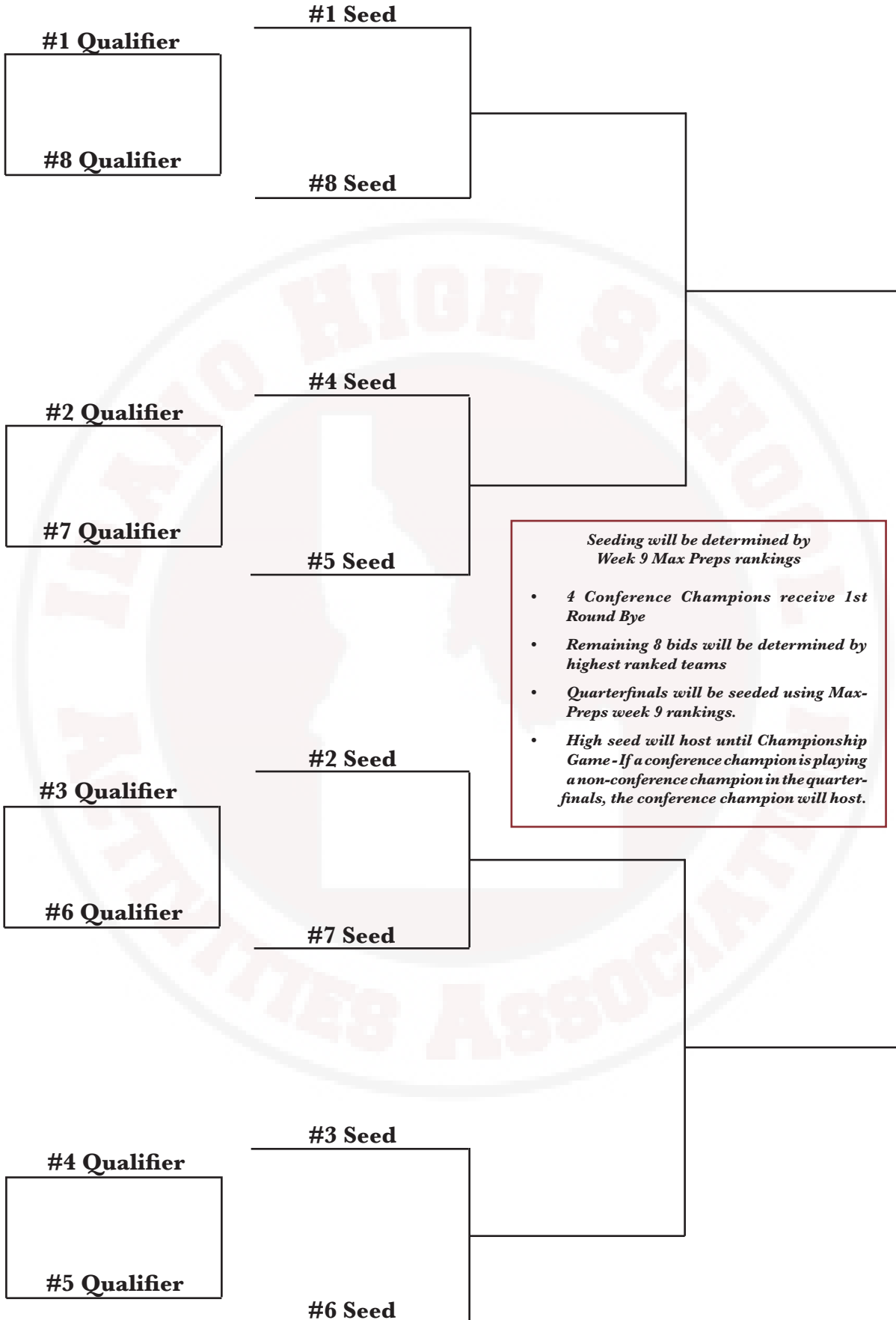
