2008 IHSAA "LEGENDS OF THE GAME"

The Idaho High School Activities Association is pleased to announce the 2008 "Legends of the Game" recipients. The award was established in 2001 to help preserve the heritage of Idaho high school sports by honoring great teams of the past. Eligible basketball "Legends" include girls' teams from at least 20 years ago and boys' teams from at least 30 years ago. Ceremonies honoring "Legends" recipients will take place during halftime of the state 5A basketball championship games at the Idaho Center. The girls' ceremonies are slated for February 16 and the boys' ceremonies will take place on March 1.

Girls' Basketball – Highland – 1985

Highland (of Pocatello) High School's 1985 basketball team, under the direction of Coach Randy Rehrer, is the seventh recipient of the IHSAA girls "Legends of the Game" award. Not only were the 1985 Lady Rams state champions, they amassed a record of 25-1. Although they met teams with many players over six feet tall, their teamwork and perseverance led them to victory.

Boys' Basketball – Preston – 1946

Preston High School's 1946 basketball team has been chosen as the eighth IHSAA boys "Legends of the Game". Under the direction of coach Robert Bunker, this talented group of young men was the first team to bring a state basketball title to Preston High School and finished their championship season with a record of 21-5, including a 9-game winning streak on their way to the state title.
