Admission Prices

General Admission \$5.00 per day

Discount Ticket* \$4.00 per day*

**Senior citizens, students grades 7-12 with an activity card and students in grades 1-6 may purchase the discount ticket. Children under 6 admitted free.*

Admission — Team Personnel

Coaches participating in the tournament will gain admission with a tournament pass issued by the tournament manager. Note: The participating coach's regular IHSAA activity card will allow only one (his/her spouse) entry to each session.

One manager, one statistician, one ball handler and eighteen players will receive participant passes. All other team support members must purchase tickets unless the principal / administrator of that school arranges for their admission at the admission gate. The school will be invoiced after the tournament for the above additional admissions.

Game Balls

Game balls must display the NFHS Authenticating mark. The home team (top team on the bracket) will provide two game balls and the visiting team (bottom team on the bracket) will provide one game ball. The teams shall provide the referee with the game balls 15 minutes prior to the start of the contest.

Governance

National Federation rules will be used for all IHSAA soccer games.

Home Team / Team Benches / Equipment

The team in the top bracket shall be the "home" team. The home team will wear light jerseys and will be assigned to the right side of the scorer's table (as you face it). Both teams and coaches areas are on the same side of the field. Teams must bring two sets of jerseys, stockings and their own practice balls and towels.

Number of Players

Each school represented at the tournament may have eighteen players in uniform at the start of competition. Violation of this rule will result in the school being assessed a maximum fine for dressing more than the approved number of players at a state tournament game with forfeiture of the game if excess numbers play.

Officials

Officials will be provided by the IHSAA. There shall be a single referee and two assistant referees who will be assisted by at least two ball holders, located at each end of the field.

Pre-Tournament Practice

No team will be allowed to practice at a state tournament site during the two weeks prior to the state tournament. To arrange for practice times and locations on Wednesday, please contact tournament managers.

Protests

The IHSAA Board of Directors does not recognize protests of sports officials' decisions. Correction of errors can only be handled in accordance with the National Federation rules.

Tie Games

District, play-in and state tournament games that are tied at the end of 80 minutes will be resolved as follows:

1. Two (2) sudden death (10) ten minute overtimes will be played. If the game is still tied after the two (2) 10 minute overtime periods, kicks from the penalty mark with five (5) members from each team alternating kicks. After all five (5) members from each team complete their penalty kicks, the team with the most goals is the winner.
2. If a tie still exists, each coach will select five (5) players (different than the first five (5) who already kicked), to take kicks in a sudden victory situation wherein if one team scores and the other team does not score, the game is ended without further kicks being taken.
3. If the score remains tied, sudden victory kicks will continue, with the coaches selecting any five (5) players to take the next set of alternating kicks. If the score still remains tied, repeat this procedure until the tie is broken.

Warm-up Between Games

Teams will have approximately twenty minutes of warm-up between games. Because of facility constraints, the tournament time schedule will be followed as closely as possible. If the games run late, the minimum warm-up time will be ten minutes.

All-Tournament Teams

The IHSAA is philosophically opposed to all-tournament team selections. It is the right of the Media to conduct polls and establish rankings. However the IHSAA will not participate in such selections nor announce them at the tournament.

Awards

Trophies will be awarded to first, second, third, and fourth place teams. Medals will be awarded to members of the Champion and Runner-up teams. Presentation of Awards will be as follows: Fourth and third place trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of those games. Second place and championship trophies will be presented at the conclusion of the championship game. State Tournament Sportsmanship awards will be given to one team in each classification.

Crowd Control / Sportsmanship Rules

Each school is responsible for the conduct of its students and adult fans. IHSAA rules require schools to provide close supervision at all contests and asks for support and cooperation of administrators in enforcing the following rules:

1. No one other than authorized individuals will be allowed on the field or in restricted areas.
2. Persons who enter the field or restricted areas will be removed from the premises for the remainder of the tournament.

The following sportsmanship rules will be in effect at all IHSAA state play-ins and championship events:

1. **Face Painting** Full and/or half face painting is not permitted. Partial face painting is permitted, i.e. small markings on cheeks, nose, forehead.
2. **Posters/Banners/Signs** All signs must display only positive support for one's own team.
3. **Artificial Noisemakers** Artificial noisemakers are prohibited.
4. **Balloons** Balloons are not permitted at any IHSAA state play off or championship event.
5. **Attire** Bare chests are not permitted. Shirts must be worn.
6. **Inappropriate Behavior** The following are not permitted:
 - a. Throwing objects onto the playing area before, during or after a contest.
 - b. Entering the playing area before, during, or after a contest.
 - c. Verbal harassment or derogatory remarks directed toward an opponent or official.

Dressing Rooms

Dressing rooms are unavailable and will not be provided. Teams need to dress at home or in their motel rooms.

Litter / Lost and Found

Participants are responsible for picking up litter from the team and coaching area. Schools should assist in keeping facilities clean by supervising spectator sections. A lost and found site will be designated by the tournament manager.

Media Credentials

Members of the media shall use their own media credentials for entrance to the tournament. For those who do not have such credentials, media passes may be requested from the IHSAA or tournament manager.

National Anthem

The National Anthem will be played at the start of each game, when possible.

Programs

The composition, printing and selling of tournament programs is the responsibility of the IHSAA. Each team will receive two complimentary souvenir programs.

Rosters and Team Pictures

Team rosters and regular season scores may be submitted via our on-line, interactive form at idhsaa.org. Send **pictures** as an attachment to an e-mail message as a high quality TIFF or JPG image to cherylm@idhsaa.org. Do not submit hard copies of rosters or scores. All materials must be received by 4:00 P.M., October 12 to insure placement in the program.

T-Shirts / Souvenir Merchandise

State tournament t-shirts and other souvenir merchandise will be sold at the tournament by McU Sports.

Training Room / Towels

Training room facilities and a trainer will be available for special assistance or in case of an emergency. However, schools should plan to furnish their own tape and supplies. Towels will not be provided at the tournament.
