- Sports information by season (Fall/Winter/Spring)

- Program success Academic Achievements, Sportsmanship Awards, District/State Trophies
- Athletic goals for the year (sportsmanship, academic support, competition, etc.)

3. Eligibility Requirements

- Academic requirements (GPA thresholds, grade checks)
- Attendance and behavior policies
- Physicals and medical clearance
- Registration process and deadlines (e.g., online platforms)

4. Expectations

- Code of Conduct for athletes and parents
- Sportsmanship (players, parents, spectators)
- Social media guidelines
- Communication protocols (chain of command: athlete \rightarrow coach \rightarrow AD \rightarrow admin)

5. Scheduling and Commitment

- Practice and game schedules (in-season and off-season)
- Attendance expectations (games, practices, team meetings)
- Out of season restrictions/rules
- Conflicts with other activities (academics, clubs, jobs)
- Transportation policies (school vs. parent-provided)

6. Health and Safety

- Concussion protocol and injury management
- Athletic training and trainer availability
- Hydration, nutrition, and rest
- Emergency contact procedures

7. Costs and Fundraising

- Participation fees or booster contributions
- Equipment and uniform expectations (what's provided vs. what's not)
- Fundraising goals and opportunities
- Scholarships or fee assistance if available

8. Booster Club & Volunteer Needs

- Role of the booster club
- Upcoming events needing volunteers (concessions, transportation, team dinners, etc.)
- Ways parents can support teams and athletes

9. College and Recruiting Guidance (Optional for Older Athletes)

- Timeline for recruiting (especially juniors/seniors)
- Role of high school coaches
- NCAA/NAIA eligibility center basics
- Importance of academics and highlight videos
