REPORT AGENDA

YEA Update

Julie Hammons reported on the YEA stating the fluctuation in the stock market has impacted the fund significantly losing about \$400,000 in just two months. Hopefully the market will take an upward swing before June 30, 2022 when disbursements are set. Deary High School has become fully vested bringing the total number of fully vested schools to 72. A committee is still looking into what can be done for fully vested schools that would like to continue to contribute to the fund and has a meeting scheduled for April 15, 2022. The next YEA Board meeting is scheduled for May 5, 2022.

Dairy West Update

Ty Jones reported on last week's meeting with Dairy West stating it was a good meeting. The winter tournaments were reviewed along with the upcoming spring events with marketing being a main topic of discussion.

Officials Update

Darren Krzesnik addressed the board with a few concerns that included hotel rooms, the numbers being down for softball and baseball officials and shot clock training.

Marketing Update

Ty Jones went over the marketing information provided by Zach Hoffman. Zach is currently focused on growing the "Unbottled" presence at our state tournaments and increasing the social media platform followers. The Athlete of the Week program sponsored by Toyota has really taken off and is really a great tool to highlight some amazing kids.

2022 State Debate

Julie Hammons reported on State Debate stating it was in person for the first time in two years and students and coaches were very excited to attend. One point of concern is with the schedule and the long days. Overall, it was a great event.

2022 State Cheer and Dance

Julie Hammons reported State Cheer and Dance was held at the Ford Idaho Center and went really well. This was the first year the event was held 5 weeks earlier than the traditional date which was a big change for many. Our net income was a little more than \$50K. Once again, the reserved seats sold out quickly with very few issues. Everything ran smoothly and turned out great.

2022 Girls Real Dairy Shootout

Ty Jones reported on Girls State Basketball stating overall it was a great tournament. Although our attendance numbers were down compared to previous years, our revenue was up. A huge thank you to our state managers. We have some great tournament managers and we couldn't do what we do without them.

2022 State Wrestling Tournament

Ty Jones reported State Wrestling was held in Pocatello this year. This was the first year we added a girl's wrestling bracket and we are very excited to be able to provide this opportunity for our female wrestlers. Both attendance and revenue were good with our net income being a little over \$40K. A huge thank you to Travis Bell, the tournament manager, for doing an outstanding job.

2022 Boys Real Dairy Shootout

Ty Jones reported on Boys State Basketball stating the tournaments were great. Our attendance numbers were pretty close to previous years however our revenue was up quite a bit. A huge thank you to all of the schools and the tournament managers that hosted these tournaments. It takes a lot of time and effort to put on these tournaments and they all did a great job.

Schools of Excellence ~ Mid-Year Standing

Julie Hammons reported mid-year standings are posted on the IHSAA website and encouraged all schools to take a look and let her know of any discrepancies. Just a reminder, the citizen component, which is the last component, is due on May 5, 2022.

Winter Concussion Numbers

Ty Jones went over the winter concussion numbers stating there are more schools reporting and fewer concussions. The numbers have gone down in almost all of sports which is good thing.

ACTION AGENDA – FINAL READINGS

Rule 2-3-2

A motion was made to approve changing wording for Classification rule 2-3-2 with modifications as needed as a Final Reading.

2-3: The IHSAA Board of Directors shall make the final determination on all classification petitions during their annual September meeting. Classification petitions will be considered for two-year cycles. Schools may petition to move up or down a classification in distinct team sports or up a classification in distinct individual sports by submitting a classification petition to the IHSAA by September 10 of the grace year. Teams may only petition down in distinct team sports.

2-3-1: Cheer, dance, football, boys soccer, girls soccer, volleyball, boys basketball, girls basketball, baseball and softball are considered team sports for the classification petitioning process.

2-3-2: Petitions must include the following to be considered when petitioning down a classification:

- A. The IHSAA office will tabulate votes from all superintendents of the classification in which the school wishes to be placed as well as the classification they will be leaving. A simple majority of the superintendent votes, one vote per high school, must be obtained to move the petition to the Board for a final decision.
- B. Cover letter and letters of support.
- C. Evidence that the varsity, JV, and freshman combined winning percentage is near or below 25% during the most recent two years of competition.
- D. Evidence that the varsity, JV, and freshman teams finished near or below in the bottom 33% of their postseason tournaments during the most recent two years of competition.
- E. The IHSAA office will organize team sport committees to review all petitions prior to coming to the IHSAA Board of Directors to be used as advisory information.

2-3-3: Petitions must include the following to be considered when petitioning up a classification:

- A. The IHSAA office will tabulate votes from all superintendents of the classification in which the school wishes to be placed as well as the classification they will be leaving. A simple majority of the superintendent votes, one vote per high school, must be obtained to move the petition to the Board for a final decision.
- B. Cover letter and letters of support.
- C. The IHSAA office will organize team sport committees to review all petitions prior to coming to the IHSAA Board of Directors to be used as advisory information.

***A region cannot host two years in a row unless both schools are from that region.**

The final decision in setting sites, dates and time for each state championship game will be made by IHSAA Representatives and will be finalized by 10:00 a.m. the Sunday prior to the state championship game.

Selection Criteria:

A. Factors determining the site of a state championship game are:

1. Idaho State University – There may be at least three games, and possibly four, scheduled at Holt Arena. Two games should be scheduled on Friday. The remaining game or games will be scheduled on Thursday or Saturday, with times to be determined by ISU’s football schedule.
2. University of Idaho — There may be a maximum of three games per day scheduled at the Kibbie Dome. If possible, games should be scheduled for Friday afternoon and evening. Game times and dates will be determined by U of I’s football schedule.
3. Boise State University — There may be two games per day played at Dona Larson/ Albertsons Stadium. Game times and dates will be determined by the Boise State football schedule.

B. Other factors determining the site of a state championship game are:

1. Travel - loss of instruction time for the two participating teams.
2. Geographical rotation based upon recent participation of the district from which the teams are participating.
3. A region may not host a state championship game two years in a row unless both teams are from the same region
4. If No. 2 and No. 3 are in conflict with each other, No. 3 will take precedence over No. 2.
5. Availability of lodging and meals for teams, support groups and spectators.
6. Availability of the site to set reasonable game times. No game may be scheduled to start after 9:00 p.m. The team traveling the farthest distance will get first choice of game time.

DISCUSSION AGENDA

1. Ty Jones went over the updated verbiage for game limitations noting this will be on the Rules and Regulations page.

Game Limitations for Each Team

No team may play more than nine games maximum for regular season play. The regular season is considered to end four weeks before the state championship game. No interschool football game will be approved unless at least five days have elapsed from the date of the previous game by that team. The term "football team" includes sophomore, junior varsity or varsity teams in grades 9-12. With approval, a team may play on the fifth day following competition.

2. The proposed guidelines/expectations for pep bands were reviewed and will be moved to the Action Agenda for the June Board of Directors Meeting.
3. Rule 4-3 Ejections was discussed and will be reviewed, updated and moved to the Action Agenda for the June Board of Directors Meeting.
4. 4A State Relay changes were discussed and a survey will be sent out to gather more input. This item will be moved to the Action Agenda for the June Board of Directors Meeting.
5. Match limitations for wrestling was discussed. Ty Jones will meet with wrestling coaches and this item will be kept on the Discussion Agenda for the June Board of Directors Meeting.
6. Rule 2-1 Classification will be updated and moved to the Action Agenda for the June Board of Directors Meeting.

**RULE 1 - ADMINISTRATIVE
AUTHORITY AND RESPONSIBILITY**

1-1 GENERAL

- 1-1-1 The principal of each member school is recognized as the school representative and, as such, is accountable to the Association for the conduct of the activities program of that school.
- 1-1-2 The principal or an authorized adult representative shall accompany each team to all contests.
- 1-1-3 The principal has the authority to designate a faculty member employed in that school system to act as activities director of the teams representing the school.
- 1-1-4 The principal must provide adequate team and crowd control at all contests in which his/her school participates and assure that participants and fans conduct themselves in a proper and sportsmanlike manner. Failure of the principal to provide adequate control or failure of the school's participants and/or fans to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner shall be deemed sufficient reason for disciplinary action by the Board of Directors.
- 1-1-5 Any school may narrow the scope of its activities and may have rules governing participants in addition to these rules provided the same do not conflict with or violate the Association rules.
- 1-1-6 The Board of Directors will not overrule a local school policy that is consistent with these rules and regulations.
- 1-1-7 Mutual agreements that violate the rules of this Association may result in disciplinary action being taken against the schools involved.
- 1-1-8 All new principals and athletic directors are required to attend annual IHSA rules and regulations workshops that are held in each activity district at the beginning of the school year.

1-2 CERTIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY

- 1-2-1 The eligibility of all contestants in sports and specific activities shall be certified by the school principal in accordance with the rules hereby adopted. An *Eligibility Verification* form must be filed with the IHSA office for each sport and specifically named activity in which a school participates.
- 1-2-2 The filing dates for eligibility verification have been determined by the Board of Directors. A late fee of \$5.00 per sport/activity will be charged for failure to file the form on or before the deadline.
