3-credit summer course

In an effort to assist in coaches' education throughout the State of Idaho, The Idaho High School Activities Association in cooperation with the NFHS and the University of Idaho is continuing an opportunity for Idaho coaches/teachers. Coaches can earn (3) college credits from the U of I by becoming a NFHS "Level 3" high school coach through coursework developed by the NFHS.

## The process can be accomplished in 4 steps.

2) Complete the NFHS coursework to obtain the "Level 3" Certificate by going to NFHSLearn.com or by clicking the link below: (there are required fees for some NFHS courses)

  - \*\* Dr. Bauscher must receive "Level 3" certificate in order to award a "P" grade
  - \*\* The "Level 3" certificate must be received by Tuesday August 8<sup>th</sup> to receive U of I credits (if certificate arrives after 8/8/23 grades will be pushed to the fall 2023 semester)
- 4) Email a copy of a two-page typed reflection paper upon completion of "Level 3" coursework to the IHSAA at federicom@idhsaa.org (the paper will be forwarded to the school administration)

## NOTES:

- Course credits (3) will only be offered during summer semester through University of Idaho
- Registration and payment for 3 credits is through the University of Idaho
- It is a P/F course grade
- "Level 3" Coursework is through NFHS Learn at NFHSLearn.com
- Reflection paper and Level 3 Certificate are required to earn credits by Tuesday 8/8/23
