EDAD 505 – Leadership/Interscholastic Coach  
3-credit summer course

In an effort to assist in coaches' education throughout the State of Idaho, The Idaho High School Activities Association in cooperation with the NFHS and the University of Idaho is announcing a new opportunity in Idaho. Coaches can earn (3) college credits from the U of I by becoming a Certified Interscholastic Coach (CIC) through coursework developed by the NFHS.

***The process can be accomplished in 4 steps.***

- 1) Register for credit on-line using the link below (no paper registration forms will be accepted for this course) beginning April 5<sup>th</sup> 2021. Payment is through the University of Idaho's Marketplace – College of Education, Health and Human Sciences' Store prior to the deadline:

**\*\* Dr. Bauscher must receive CIC certificate in order to award a "P" grade**  
**\*\* The CIC certificate must be received by Friday August 6<sup>th</sup> to receive U of I credits**  
**(if certificate arrives after 8/6/21 grades will be pushed to the fall semester)**
- 4) Email a copy of a two-page typed reflection paper upon completion of CIC coursework to the IHSAA at [federicom@idhsaa.org](mailto:federicom@idhsaa.org) (the paper will be forwarded to the school administration)
  - This course and credits will only be offered in the summer semester through the University of Idaho.
  - It is a P/F course grade
  - **The CIC certificate must be received by Friday August 6<sup>th</sup> to receive U of I credit**
