
2022 Hall of Fame Inductee

Dave Mills, Boise High School



Dave Mills is one of the most prolific and influential cross country and track coaches in Idaho history. He served the students of Idaho for forty-one years and worked in all levels of education from elementary school through post-secondary education.

He spent the majority of his career working as an elementary physical education specialist with the Boise School District while also coaching cross country and track at Boise High School. He coached ten state champion cross country teams, two state champion track teams, eleven individual cross-country champions and forty-four individual track champions. Mills was instrumental in numerous IHSAA cross country and track policy changes including the addition of the hardship rules for state qualifiers and adding wheelchair/para-athletes to the state track meet. Mills continues to volunteer as a collegiate cross-country coach.
