#### **CURRENT LANGUAGE**

 The officials shall issue a card to the coach or school administrator when a player/ coach/staff/parent/fan/spectator is ejected from competition. The card <u>must</u> be issued at or prior to the conclusion of the competition in which the infraction occurred.

#### **PROPOSED LANGUAGE**

 The official/commissioner shall issue a card report an ejection to the school's Principal and Athletic Director to the coach or school administrator when a player/coach/staff/parent/fan/spectator is ejected from a competition. The card report must be issued at or prior to the conclusion of the competition submitted within a 24-hour period of the conclusion of the competition in which the infraction occurred.
