# 2021 Spring State Tournament Protocols

In accordance with the State Board of Education (OSBE) Spectator Attendance Directive; [https://idhsaa.org/asset/covid/Spring%20School%20Events%20memo\\_03.16.2021\[1\].pdf](https://idhsaa.org/asset/covid/Spring%20School%20Events%20memo_03.16.2021[1].pdf) the IHSAA has developed the following spring state tournament protocols:

### **General Guidelines** - *Applicable at all IHSAA Spring 2021 State Events*

- All attendees are expected to follow social distancing guidelines.
- Masks are highly recommended at all outdoor events.
- School personnel and team members will be asked to clear facilities at the completion of their contests.
- Spectators should only attend the contest/event that their student is participating in.

### **Sport Specific Considerations:**

#### **GOLF**

- Masks are required in the clubhouse.
- Award ceremonies may be modified.
- Coaches, students, spectators, etc.... shall not congregate in the clubhouse (plan ahead for inclement weather)
- Leaderboard postings should be spread out to avoid crowding.

#### **TENNIS**

- Concessions will not be provided.
- Congregating in any area of a tennis complex should be avoided.
- Masks are required in the clubhouse.

#### **TRACK & FIELD**

- Tickets will only be available on-line through the Go-Fan platform.
- Tickets will not be available at the gate.
- Tickets will be available daily at a minimum 40% of venue capacity.
- Concessions may be limited.

#### **SOFTBALL**

- Private ticket links will be available through each participating school.
- Tickets will only be available on-line through the Go-Fan platform.
- Tickets will not be available at the gate.
- Tickets will be available daily at a minimum 40% of venue capacity.
- Award ceremonies may be modified.
- Concessions may be limited.
