



Athletic Events Protocol

Gymnasium

Middle AND High School Games:

No visiting spectators will be allowed into the facility. Only athletes and team staff (coaches, bookkeeper).

Masks are required by Idaho City Middle/High School.

All persons entering the facility will be required to wear a mask or shield at all times except players participating in the game(s). All persons entering the facility will also have their temperature taken. If temperature is 100.4 or greater that person will not be allowed to enter the facility. Hand sanitizer will be available for spectators and team personnel upon entry.

It will be required for all persons to maintain social distancing of six feet or greater from individuals not in the same household.

One Way-Entry and Exit doors will be utilized.

Concessions will NOT be provided.

Games will also be streamed format to be decided. All teams will be notified.

Idaho City Middle/High School reserves the right to adjust this plan as necessary to protect our students, staff, and community.

Idaho City Middle/ High School also reserves the right to ask persons to leave if they fail to comply with the mask/face shield, social distancing and/ or other reason(s) that are not in line with the protocol/ expectations.

Football Field

Middle/High School Games:

Masks are required by Idaho City Middle/High School.

It will be required for all persons to maintain social distancing of six feet or greater from individuals not in the same household.

VEHICLE VIEWING AREA- We have limited spots located above the football field and around the gravel track. These spots will be reserved for people viewing the game from their vehicle.

Athletic Travel and Competition Protocol

Pre-Departure:

Athletic Director will contact host school administrator:

-3 days before competition to check-in and confirm time and arrival

-1 day prior to scheduled competition to conduct Health/Safety Questionnaire.

AD/Coaches will notify parents and players of any host site protocols that may apply.

Health/Safety Questions for Host Schools:

- 1) Does your school adhere to established local board approved guidelines pertaining to COVID -19?
- 2) Do your athletic programs follow an approved health/safety protocol for athlete participation on a daily basis?
- 3) Have any athletes/athletic staff been quarantined in the last 14 days?
- 4) Do you currently have any evidence of confirmed community spread within your school?

Team Procedures:

- A) Temperature checks will be conducted prior to loading onto the bus, including driver and staff.
- B) All student/athletes and staff will wear masks while in transit.
- C) Busses will make NO stops while student/athletes are on bus.
- D) Masks will be worn at all times prior to pregame or warm-ups.
- E) Teams will not use host site locker rooms.
- F) All athletes will social distance as much as possible.
- G) Limit any non-essential personnel.
- H) All teams will adhere to the guidelines provided by the NFHS and the IHSAA.
