

# Lewiston High School: 2020-21 Athletics/Activities COVID-19 Protocol

## **Event Attendance / Fans Allowance:**

*Stage 1* - No fans in attendance (possible streaming options)

*Stage 2* - No fans in attendance (possible streaming options)

*Stage 3* - Direct family only (possible streaming options)

*Stage 4* - Social/physical distancing encouraged/promoted/recommended. Signage will be displayed and expectation information will be provided to potential attendees prior to contests.

If social/physical distancing cannot be maintained, we strongly recommend the utilization of a face covering/mask and/or shield.

*\*\* Stages as determined by State of Idaho / Idaho Governor stages of reopening.*

## **Travel:**

- All travel, including to and from practice as well as to and from contests/activities, will require masks of all passengers/drivers.

## **Symptomatic participant/coach:**

- Students and/or coaches that demonstrate possible symptoms, will be subject to COVID-19 screening questions.
- If a student and/or coach exhibits a fever, that individual will be sent home for a 24 hour period. During this time, the fever must subside without the use of a fever relieving medication or anti-inflammatories (i.e. aspirin), before the individual is able to return to activity.

## **COVID-19 Positive Test:**

- Any participant, coach or athletic personnel that tests positive for COVID-19, will be Quarantined for a 14 day period. Following the 14 day quarantine, the individual must be fever free, without use of fever reducing medication or anti-inflammatories, before being allowed to return. Return to activity date/time will be determined with consultation with the North Idaho Health District.

- Upon return to activity, participants will be subject to a progressive return to activity (practice/contests), to ensure their safety. This progressive return will be conducted by Lewiston High School athletic training staff. Return dates/times may vary depending on severity of illness and individual.
- Participants and/or staff members who have been in close contact with the identified individual will be required to Quarantine for 14 days. This will include staff members or students who have been within 6 feet of the individual for 15 minutes or more on a daily basis without wearing a face covering. Contact tracing to determine “close contact” as it is defined, will be conducted by the North Idaho Health District.
- Facilities that may have been exposed will be shut down for 48 hours for deep cleaning.
