Category 1: Normal Learning 10 Active Cases (Monitored (Probable & Confirmed): All staff and students in the school buildings.

(Vulnerable Students will be able to complete the Blended Learning Plan Document and set up for digital learning/ Vulnerable Staff will complete the staff accommodations form)

- ♣ Return to normal school routines.
- ♣ Face coverings are optional.
- ♣ Policies are normal per District Policy and Student Handbooks.
- ♣ No statewide or local stay-home orders are in place.
- ♣ The statewide reopening criteria have been met as defined at <https://rebound.idaho.gov/>.
- ♣ Cleaning and Sanitation protocols are in place.
- ♣ Routine health screenings (See Student Daily Health Assessment/ Employee Daily Health Assessment).
- ♣ Communication Plan is in place (All contact to parents will be posted on the District Website and Facebook Page and an email list has been created.)

Category 2: Blended Learning 10+ Active Cases (Monitored (Probable & Confirmed): All staff and most students in the school buildings.

(Vulnerable Students will be able to complete the Blended Learning Plan Document and set up for digital learning/ Vulnerable Staff will complete the staff accommodations form)

- ♣ Minimal to moderate community transmission.
- ♣ Face coverings are recommended
- ♣ Attendance Policy may be altered in accordance with ISBOE Education and the SDE.
- ♣ Schoolwide social distancing and mitigation strategies are in place. Schools have a physical distancing plan in place that has been developed with guidance from (SIPH) which allows for social distancing where/if possible. Options for physical distancing may require alternate schedules for lunch (eat in classrooms, outside or other areas set up), recesses and adjusted transitioning to classes
- ♣ Parents are informed of inherent risk of attending school, participating in athletic and activities, and of riding buses.
- ♣ Cleaning and Sanitation protocols are in place.
- ♣ Routine health screenings (See Student Daily Health Assessment/ Employee Daily Health Assessment).

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Please keep in mind that current plans are fluid and will be updated as additional recommendations are made. We would ask that you send your student with a water bottle as only the filling stations will be usable at the school. We have a new filling station/ water foundation in the elementary as well as the one that we have at the front of the school. We have hand sanitizing stations in all rooms and in several locations around the school. We have around 20 gallons of hand sanitizer and lots of containers for all this hand sanitizer. We have various locations that will be set up as alternate places for students to eat as well. We will have cleaning supplies readily available and sanitizing plans put in place to keep our staff and students safe. Right now we are at a Category 1.
