- d. Exemptions.
- iv. Extra-curricular activities, including athletics, practice, matches, performances and games may continue. Participants necessary for the extra-curricular activity to occur include, but are not limited to, players, instructors, coaches, officials, and personnel to broadcast the activity. Attendance by non-participants, including spectators, remains subject to the requirements specified in this Order, including but not limited to, those identified in Sections 1(a) and 3; and

In light of Governor Little's recent public health order, moving Idaho to a Stage 2, school districts across the state are making some adjustments to athletic events. PCSD 25 has made the following adjustments:

High School

- No spectators
 - Spectators will be able to watch using NFHSnetwork.com
- Visiting team will wait in alternative location while waiting for games.
- Athletics/Activities will follow any additional state guidelines (IHSAA).
- **No Cheer and/or Dance during stage 2**
- ALL banquets will be held through zoom or google meet in stage 2.
- All teams will be restricted to 10 minute inside locker rooms. (team meeting in open area where distance can be maintained)
- Ensure that hand sanitizer is available at all contests and practices. Participants/athletes, coaches and officials clean hands frequently.
- Equipment wiped down as frequently as possible.
- Coaches are required to wear masks at all times.
- Athletes will wear masks at all times other than when they are in the game.
- No shared water bottles, towels or other personal equipment.
- No pre-game and post-game contact, such as handshakes/high-fives/fist bumps. Practice limited contact among athletes.

Middle School

- ALL banquets will be held through zoom or google meet in stage 2

- Middle School events no spectators.
- Middle School cheer are required to wear masks at all times (unless conditioning at practice).
