COVID-19 Protocols and Return to Play
Plan & Guidelines

- Assumption of the risk and waiver of liability relating to coronavirus form must be signed/agreed upon by all athletes and parents/guardians of athletes who wish to participate in athletics during the 2020-2021 seasons. This form can be completed on planeths.com, which can be accessed through wendelltrojans.com.
- Student athletes will provide their own hydration source and will not share hydration sources.
- Athletes, coaches, and other staff alike will wash/sanitize their hands on a frequent basis during the day, practices, and events.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be provided at various convenient locations by Wendell School District, for use by all athletes, coaches, support staff and fans.
- In the event that a student-athlete, coach, or support staff is feeling ill it is recommended by Wendell School District that the individual stay home and not return to play/coach until he/she is feeling well again.
- In the event that an athlete, coach, or support staff individual tests positive for COVID-19, he/she shall not return to practices or events until released by a medical professional for return.
- Masks are permitted, but not required by WSD., EXCEPT when traveling. Masks will be required by all who travel on WSD buses.
- We encourage all fans and spectators to maintain social distancing in accordance with the 6 ft rule.
- Coaches and support staff will sanitize equipment on a daily basis.
- WSD athletics will continue to monitor the COVID-19 pandemic and modify all plans and guidelines based on the State of Idaho's Rebound plan and the IHSAA and NFHS guidelines.
