Ben Kerfoot – 1992 Hall of Fame Inductee



Ben Kerfoot retired in 1991 from the Fruitland School District after serving as superintendent of schools and basketball coach. As boys' basketball coach he finished with a record of 143-87 and his team won the District 3 championship three times. Coaching girls' basketball, Kerfoot had a record of 142-24 and won four district championships. In 1982 his team had a record of 25-1 and was the state consolation winner.

Kerfoot served for 15 years as a member of the IHSAA Board of Directors. He also served the State Superintendents Association as president and was voted as Superintendent of the Year in 1991. Kerfoot served on the Executive Board of the National Federation of State High School Associations representing 11 states.
