Bob Squires – 2004 Hall of Fame Inductee



For over forty years, Bob Squires was a guiding influence on student-athletes in north-central Idaho. His career began in 1959 at Clearwater Valley where he taught and coached for three years. He then spent two years in American Falls before moving to Kamiah in 1964. At Kamiah, Bob taught at the middle school and junior high and was the high school's head boys track coach for thirty-one years and girls track coach for eighteen. He also spent many years as an assistant football coach.

Bob retired from teaching in 1993, but continued coaching track through the 2003 season. A successful and highly respected coach, Bob's boys and girls track teams won a combined eight state championships, four state runner-up trophies, fifteen top-four state finishes, and thirty-four district/regional championships.
