

Brent Faure – 2013 Hall of Fame Inductee



Brent Faure's career spanned thirty-one years, beginning as an elementary PE specialist in Pocatello before moving to Highland High School in 1981. For twenty-seven years, Brent served Highland High School students as a teacher and head athletic trainer. In 1986 Brent wrote the curriculum and taught the first curricular sports medicine program in the state. Brent moved to Century High School in 2008 teaching sports medicine and EMT classes before his retirement in 2013.

In addition to his career in education, Brent served as owner and operator of Tri Med Ambulance and Tri Med Sports Medicine providing invaluable athletic training services to schools in the area. Brent was also instrumental in helping to develop IHSAA's wrestling weight management and certification program as well as coordinating sports medicine coverage for numerous IHSAA state tournaments. His work with concussion education and management was also invaluable to students across the state of Idaho.
