

Chuck Kinsey – 2010 Hall of Fame Inductee



For thirty-six years, Chuck Kinsey dedicated his career to high school athletics and activities. He began his career in Illinois in 1971 before moving to Indiana where he taught, coached, and served as a principal. In 1985, Chuck and his family moved to Rathdrum, Idaho where he took the job as principal of Lakeland High School. After twelve years as principal, Chuck became assistant superintendent of the Lakeland School District in 1997 and was named superintendent in 2001. Chuck retired in 2008.

Throughout his administrative career, Chuck served on numerous boards in a variety of capacities. He was a member of the District I Board of Control from 1989-2008, the IHSAA Board of Directors from 1998-2008 in two different positions, and was a member of the Idaho School District council for three years.
