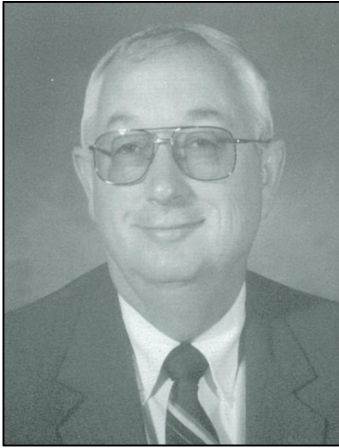


Dale Thornsberry – 2005 Hall of Fame Inductee



A strong desire to enrich the lives of others was the cornerstone of Dale Thornsberry's thirty-five years as a teacher, counselor, administrator, and educational leader. His career, which took him to a variety of schools, began in 1965 in Blackfoot. After leaving Blackfoot he had tenures in Oregon, at Nampa High School, and at Buhl High School. Dale then moved to Boise to serve for two years as Assistant Director of the IHSAA.

In 1988, Dale began six years in Twin Falls as principal of Robert Stuart Junior High. He then taught five years at the college level. In 1994 Dale returned to Twin Falls to become Director of Operations for the Twin Falls School District, a position he held until retiring in June of 2000.
