
Don Armstrong – 2007 Hall of Fame Inductee



Don Armstrong's career began in Oregon in 1967 where he spent eight years before moving to northern Idaho in 1975. For nine years Armstrong was high school principal and then superintendent at Bonners Ferry. In 1984 he moved to Potlatch, serving as superintendent of schools for eighteen years before "halfway" retiring in 2002. For the next four years he served Kamiah and then Troy as part-time superintendent, retiring permanently in 2006.

Armstrong served a combined ten years on the District I and District II Boards of Control, represented District II on the IHSAA Board of Directors for six years, and chaired the IHSAA state sportsmanship committee for the first five years of its existence.
