Dr. Leon G. Green – 1990 Hall of Fame Inductee



Dr. Leon Green's career spanned 41 years and touched the lives of thousands of Idaho's young people as a director of health, physical education, recreation, dance, and athletics. Green's credits are many, respective to published works and public speaking, mostly in the promotion of recreational hobbies and athletics.

In 1974, Dr. Green participated in the construction of the Kibbie Dome and developed tennis courts, playfields, and basketball courts adjacent to living groups between 1960 and 1974. Among his many distinctions is being recognized as Who's Who in Education; Who's Who in the West; receiving the Inland Empire 25 Year Award for Contributions to Sports; and being inducted into the Idaho Hall of Fame for Athletics.
