
George Arrossa – 2009 Hall of Fame Inductee



George Arrossa made a positive and significant impact as a teacher, coach, and administrator for thirty-five years. George began his career in 1972 as a teacher and coach at Kimberly High School. He became a vice-principal at Twin Falls High School in 1988, but after one year, returned to Kimberly where he remained until his retirement in 2007.

During his tenure at Kimberly he coached football, basketball, and track, and served as the district athletic director. He developed and implemented a program stressing academic success, sportsmanship, citizenship, fair play, and integrity at Kimberly High School. George was also instrumental in adding new activity programs and providing funding to give more students a chance to participate in activities.
