
Harvie "Slug" Walker – 1986 Hall of Fame Inductee



Harvie Walker was a native of Scranton, Pennsylvania where he had an outstanding athletic career before competing at the University of Idaho on the football, track, and baseball teams. He took his first teaching position in Washington before moving to Lewiston in 1936. He coached all sports, taught P.E. and officiated for more than 25 years in football, basketball, and baseball.

During World War II, Walker served with the 41st Division from 1940-45 as a unit commander, returning to Lewiston after the war to continue his coaching career and start the city's high successful American Legion baseball program.
