Homer Williams was born in Malad, Idaho. He worked as a teacher, coach, principal, and superintendent of schools from 1930 to 1965. He was also a member of the IHSAA Board of Control for almost 17 years and was president of the board two times. Homer was a member of the executive committee of the National Federation of State High School Associations for three years and served as president in 1958. He also served as the executive secretary of the IHSAA from 1965 to 1975.
