Hugh Brady – 2003 Hall of Fame Inductee



Hugh Brady was a generous benefactor and valued contributor to Idaho high school athletics for forty-seven years. As the long-time owner of Idaho Sporting Goods, he sponsored numerous meeting and tournament hospitality rooms, furnished state schools with quality athletic equipment, and provided financial assistance to disadvantaged student-athletes.

Starting in 1954, Hugh attended every State Coaches Clinic and never missed a state boys' basketball tournament. Generous with time as well as money, Hugh was a volunteer timer at the state track meet for thirty-two years, coached Little League baseball, and was involved with a variety of community foundations. He was a driving force in the establishment of Bishop Kelly High School and served as a Board member for many years.
