
Jack Acree – 2003 Hall of Fame Inductee



Jack Acree will long be remembered for his dedication to interscholastic activities and professional development at the local, district, state, and national levels. His forty-year career was spent in the Boise School District, where, in 1960, he began teaching and coaching at the junior high level. In 1964, Jack spent one year at Boise High then transferred to Capital where he taught, coached, and was athletic director for three years.

In 1968, Jack moved into district administration as Elementary Physical Education Supervisor, and, in 1973, became the Boise Schools Coordinator of Physical Education and Athletics, a position he held for twenty-six years until retiring in 2000. Throughout his career Jack was actively involved in all facets of Idaho high school athletics and was instrumental in the development of the Idaho Athletic Directors Association.
