Launa Moser – 2017 Hall of Fame Inductee



Launa Moser had a profound impact on hundreds of student-athletes in her elaborate 41-year career as an educator. As one of the most outstanding volleyball coaches in the state of Idaho, Moser compiled an 83% winning percentage and participated in 19 state championships in her 22 years. During that time, Preston High School earned a state trophy 16 times including 5 state championships. Throughout her career Moser also coached basketball, track, softball, and was the leader of the pep band while teaching health/health occupations, PE and girls chorus at Preston.

Moser served with the State Department of Education as the Network Coordinator of the Idaho Southeastern Health Education Network. At the state activities level, Moser worked as a coach's representative on the 5th District Board of Control and the Idaho State Coaches Board.

In 2002, Moser co-authored a 300-page book on coaching Volleyball called Coaching Volleyball: Building a Winning Team. It is the adopted textbook for the United States Volleyball Association for coaches of private club teams.
