Phil Homer – 2005 Hall of Fame Inductee



A lifelong educator, advocate for school improvement, and supporter of Idaho high school activities, Phil Homer retired as superintendent of Blaine County Schools in 1999. His career began in 1961 as a teacher and coach in Soda Springs. After a brief tenure in Pocatello, he moved to Hailey in 1966, where he taught and coached for four years. He then moved into administration, first as principal of Wood River Junior High, and then as principal of Wood River High School.

In 1988, Phil assumed the position of Superintendent of Schools, serving in that capacity until his retirement. Phil also served as a leader of both district and state professional organizations, including fifteen years on the District IV Board of Control, four years on the IHSAA Youth Endowment Board, and three years on the IASSP Board of Directors.
