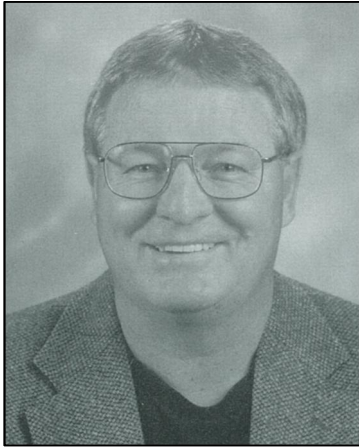


Roy Smith – 2005 Hall of Fame Inductee



Known for a keen sense of humor and his enthusiastic support of interscholastic activities, Roy Smith was a positive influence on the students of Eastern Idaho for thirty-four years. His career began in 1969 at Shelley High School, where he spent fifteen years as a teacher, multi-sport coach, and assistant principal. In 1984, Roy returned to his hometown of Ririe to become principal of Ririe High School, a position he held for nineteen years before retiring in August of 2003.

Throughout his career, Roy's focus was on increasing opportunities and providing quality experiences for student-participants throughout Idaho. Roy made significant and lasting contributions to organizations at the local, district, and state levels. He was president of the Nuclear League Principals for six years and served on the District VI Board of Control. Roy represented secondary principals on the IHSAA Board of Directors for five years.
