In an effort to assist in coaches' education throughout the State of Idaho, The Idaho High School Activities Association in cooperation with the NFHS and the University of Idaho is announcing a new opportunity in Idaho. Coaches can earn (3) college credits from the U of I by becoming a Certified Interscholastic Coach (CIC) through coursework developed by the NFHS.

***The process can be accomplished in 4 steps.***

- 1) Sign up for credit on the attached registration form and email the completed form or mail completed form (photo copies are NOT accepted) **AND** mail a check of \$180.00 (3 credit course, \$60.00 per credit) to the University of Idaho prior to the registration deadline at the address below:

- This course and credits will only be offered in the summer semester through the University of Idaho.
