2016 Hall of Fame Banquet

NFHS 2015-2016 Participation Numbers

Ty Jones reported nation wide participation numbers have increased. Idaho participation numbers increased by 2,500 students. Over 19,000 Idaho students are participating in non-sport activities.

Section 7/8 Conference - September 18-20, 2016 Phoenix, Arizona

Tracy Fuller reported on concussion insurance and transgender issues in other states. Jeff Cirka reported the eligibility process across states varies and that sportsmanship is an issue at their state tournaments. Other states are interested in Idaho's model for sportsmanship at state tournaments. Ty Jones reported Idaho fees are still very low in comparison to fees around the nation. International students procedures were discussed. Julie Hammons reported the state associations from Section 7/8 are working off more of a business model to keep the cost down for member schools.

Ty Jones reported attendance was great. IHSAA policies were a main topic.

Ty Jones reported there were very few changes. The issue of implementing a review system for 4-3 Ejections that weren't called at the time was discussed.
