1986-87

YEAR END REPORT

The Youth Endowment for Activities Foundation, Inc. concluded the 1986-87 school year on schedule. A thirteen member Board of Directors was enlisted and a full time Director was identified and hired.

Two members from each of the six activity districts were selected to serve on the Board of Directors. One member from the school system, and one member from the community. The Executive Director of the Idaho High School Activities Association is also a member and serves as the President of the the foundation.

Bob Donohue, Bob Dreyer, Bob Sobotta, Bruce Sweeney, Roger Reynoldson, Bill Campbell, Rich Bauscher, Rudy Ashenbrenner, Harris Allen, Jim Fox, Bill Stuart, and Ann Rydalch were selected to serve as Board of Directors.

With the authorization of the IHSAA Board of Directors, each of the 126 member schools were assessed a fee according to enrollment size. This money would be used to pay administrative costs of the endowment project. In addition, \$5 was added to the cost of activity cards and official registrations. These assessments will generate in excess of \$70,000.

The Board developed a job description for the position of Director. This group then advertised for the position and interviewed selected candidates. Bill McKenzie, of Hilton Head Island, South Carolina was offered the position of Director and he accepted. Mr. McKenzie was scheduled to start on July 18, 1987.

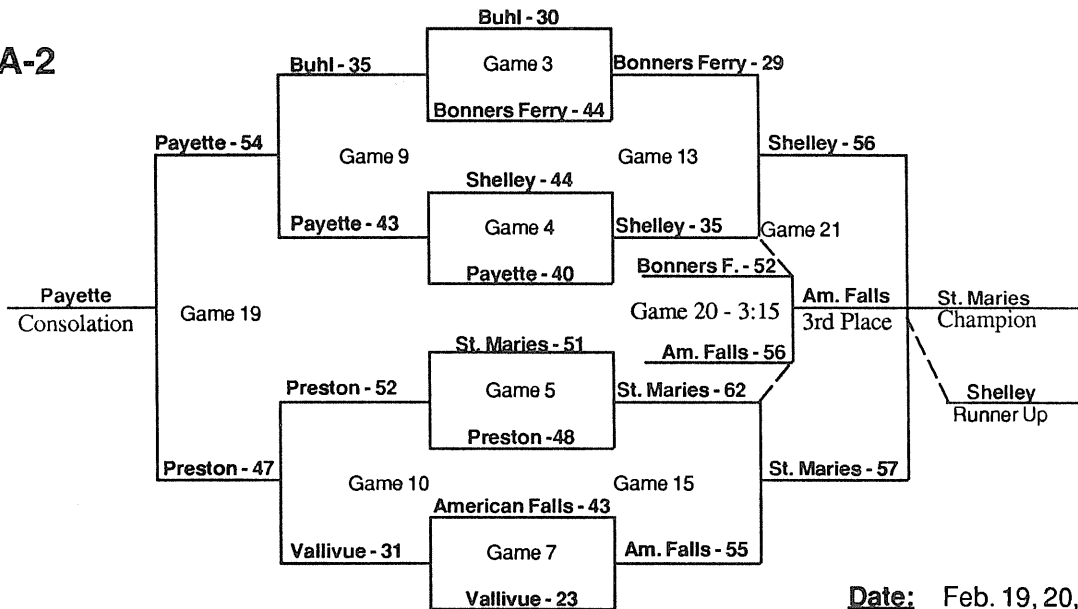
The Board reaffirmed its commitment to raising 7 million dollars and agreed to attempt to do this by July of 1988.

The Board and the Director also agreed that it would be their goal to raise 5 million dollars from Corporations and large gifts; and to raise 2 million dollars from the schools in small donations.

This most ambitious task will be announced in a press conference during the month of September and a systematic fund raising campaign will follow.
