4. Knows the game is for the athletes, and lets them have the spotlight.



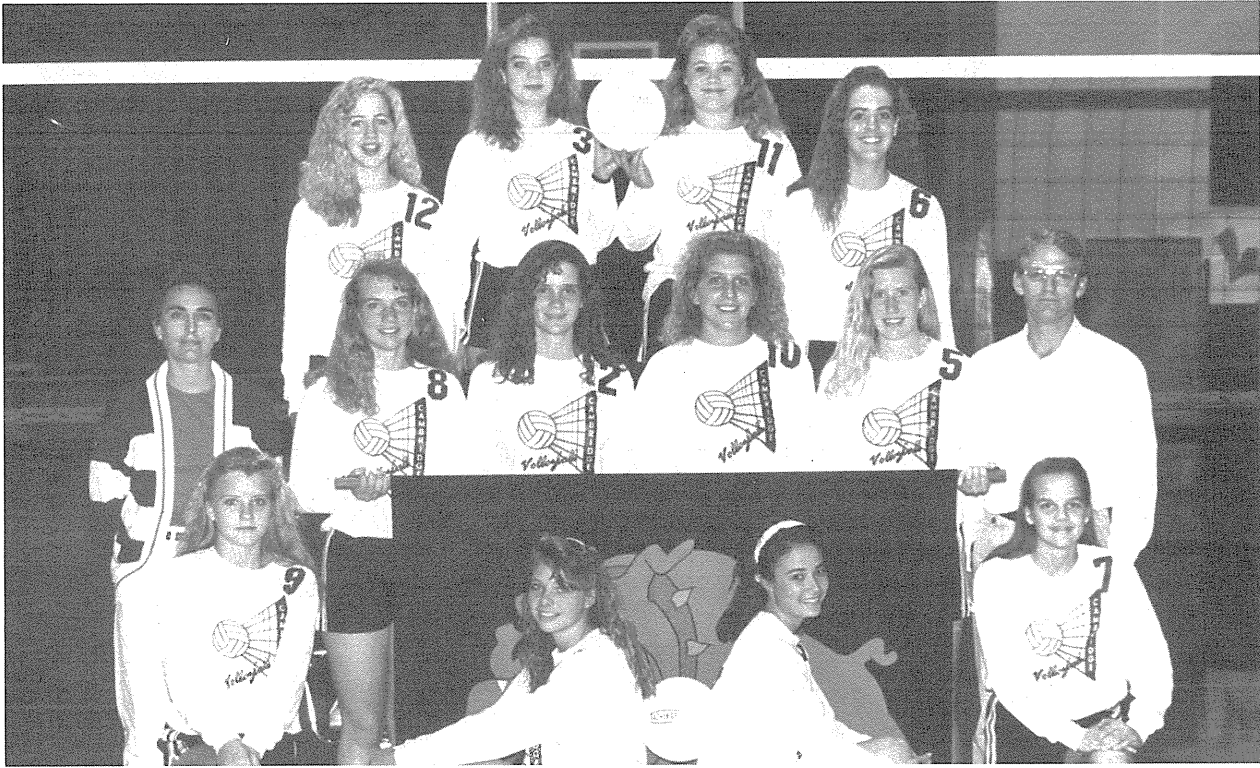
